## FRONT CONTROL ARM TO CHASSIS BUSH

**INSTALLATION GUIDE** 

## **Product description:**

PFF5-402 comes as an assembled bush ready to press into the front control arm, the bush is made up of a polyurethane ball bonded to the stainless steel sleeve which allows the bush to twist on the 2 stainless steel cups.

## **Contents (parts per pack):**

2 x bush assemblies

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- all safety precautions adhered to;
- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work. All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

## **Fitting Instructions:**

- 1. Remove the front lower control arm.
- 2. Make a note of which way around the offset sleeve is fitted then remove the bush from the arm.
- 3. The new bush needs to be pressed into the arm, make sure the longer sleeve on the new bush is fitted the same side as the original one.
- Place the narrower end (shorter sleeve side) into the arm and press the bush in until it stops against the larger diameter on the outer shell.
- Refit the arm back onto the car
- Road test car.
