PFR69-124 - REAR SUBFRAME FRONT OUTRIGGER TO CHASSIS BUSH (1)

Contents (parts per pack):

1 x bush - Upper 'B'

1 x bush - Lower 'A'

1 x centre metal sleeves

1 x grease sachet

Fitting Instructions:

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment.

These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- all safety precautions are adhered to;
- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted after any suspension work.

All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

- 1. Remove right hand side rear subframe front outrigger to chassis mount bush. A dedicated removal tool may be used to ease the removal of the original bush.
- 2. Clean bore of any burrs or dirt, and lubricate the inside of the subframe tube with a light film of grease supplied.
- 3. Hand fit new Powerflex bush into the subframe. Note; bush marked 69-124B is the thinner upper half, 69-124A is the thicker lower half
- 4. With the bush in place, reposition the subframe
- 5. Liberally lubricate the bore of the new bushes with grease supplied and press new metal sleeve inside the bush
- 6. Reassemble the subframe back to the car using the original nut's, bolts and mounting plate etc.
- 7. Tighten all hardware to manufacturer's original torque settings.
- 8. Test drive the vehicle. It is advisable to perform full wheel alignment check and adjustment as required.
